18. Cite the journal articles published in the last 5 years.
19. The citations include from journal articles at least 80% of the total references cited.
20. Use Grammarly (Grammar Checker Software) to check grammatical errors and spelling.
21. Submit the manuscript to Open Journal Systems (OJS).
